
FACTS ABOUT CORONAVIRUS COVID-19

DEFINITIONS (LiveWell, April 2, 2020)

- 1. <u>EPIDEMIC</u> A disease that affects a large number of people within a community, population, or region.
- 2. <u>PANDEMIC</u> An epidemic that has spread over multiple countries or continents.
- 3. <u>ENDEMIC</u> Something that belongs to a particular people, country, or locality. Restricted or peculiar to a locality or region.
- 4. <u>OUTBREAK</u> A greater-than-anticipated increase in the number of endemic cases. It can also be a single new case in a new area. If not quickly controlled, an outbreak can become an epidemic.

EPIDEMIC VS. PANDEMIC

The author of the write-up has given us a tip in order to remember the difference between an epidemic and a pandemic. Remember the "P" in pandemic has a "Passport." A pandemic is an epidemic that travels! (LiveWell, April 2, 2020)

HISTORIAL DATA OF PREVIOUS EPIDEMICS

YEAR	HISTORY
1918	SPANISH INFLUENZA
	A deadly flu emerged at the end of World War I, "deadlier in its full force than any infectious disease in human history."
	This Pandemic lasted until the end of 1920. "The flu had reached virtually every corner of the planet.
	Hundreds of millions were infected, with an estimation of at least 50 million dying. Entire cities were shut down because of it.
1960	<u>MEASLES</u>
	Measles is a highly contagious, airborne disease which spreads easily from one person to the next through coughs and sneezes, or direct contact with mouth or nasal secretions of infected people. Only humans are known to get measles. Most people do not get measles more than once. Measles is the most contagious

	transmissible virus known.
	Measles were declared eradicated in 2000 due to global vaccination. However, there have been cases and outbreaks since that time because of the distrust of vaccinations and the parents who refuse to have their children vaccinated. The measles vaccine is effective in preventing the disease and is safe. Vaccination resulted in an 80% decrease in deaths between 2000 and 2017, with about 85% of children worldwide having received their first dose as of 2017.
	Between 2003and 2015, no one in the U.S. died from measles. One woman died in 2015, although previously vaccinated. Her autoimmune medicine nullified the effect of the measles vaccination. As immunizations decreased from 2017 to 2019, deaths increased. A resurgence of measles occurred during 2019, as many parents would not have their children vaccinated.
1977	<u>SMALL POX</u>
	"Small Pox was a disease that killed hundreds of millions in the 20 th Century. In the U.S., small pox became an epidemic. It was estimated to have infected 300 million people in the 20th Century before it became the only human infectious disease ever to be completely eradicated."
1981	HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV)
	HIV is the virus that leads to Autoimmune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS). HIV arrived in the United States in 1981 and became a "major epidemic of the end of the 20 th Century. Thirty-two million (32,000,000) people have died of HIV/AIDS and 37.9 million people are living with it.

YEAR	VIRUS
	West Africa, from December 2013 to January 2016, with 28,646 cases and 11,323 deaths. It was declared no longer an emergency on March 29, 2016. However, other outbreaks in Africa occurred in the DRC in 2017, 2018, and 2019. An ebola vaccine was approved in the U.S. in December 2019 and more than 100,000 people were vaccinated against Ebola as of that date.
1997	H5N1 BIRD FLU / AVIAN FLU
	H5N1 is a virus that causes Avian flu or bird flu. H5N1 refers to a group of diseases that result from infections with specific influenza viruses, which infect birds but rarely spread among humans. The first outbreak of H5N1 avian flu in humans occurred in 1997 in Hong Kong. Humans can acquire the infection and develop the illness after coming into unprotected contact with birds that are carrying the virus, even with infected poultry for slaughtering, butchering, or cooking.
2002	SEVERE ACUTE RESPIRATORY SYNDROME (SARS)
	SARS is a contagious and sometimes fatal respiratory illness caused by a coronavirus. SARS first appeared in China. It spread worldwide within a few months, although it was quickly contained. No known transmissions have occurred since 2004. SARS had 8,008 cumulative cases and 774 deaths.
2009	H1N1 FLU / SWINE FLU
	H1N1 flu is a human respiratory infection caused by an influenza strain that started in pigs. It was first detected in the United States and spread quickly across the U.S. and the world, causing 12,469 flu-related deaths in the U.S. (with 151,700-575,400 worldwide.
	This new H1N1 virus at the time contained a unique combination of influenza genes not previously identified in animals or people, The H1N1 2009 virus was very different from H1N1 viruses that were circulating at the time of the pandemic. Nearly one third of the over 60 year old population had antibodies against this virus as opposed to the younger population who had none. This virus, therefore, affected more people younger than 65. The U.S. mounted a complex, multi-faceted and long-term response to the pandemic. On August 10, 2010, WHO declared an end to the global 2009 H1N1 influenza pandemic. However, since then, H1N1 flu virus has circulated seasonally in the U.S., causing significant illnesses, hospitalizations, and deaths.
2012- 2020	MIDDLE EAST RESPIRATORY SYNDROME CORONAVIRUS (MERS) / CAMEL FLU
	MERS is a contagious, sometimes fatal respiratory illness, often spread through contact with an infected person. It was first reported in Saudi Arabia in 2012 and has since spread to other countries, including the U.S, although most cases occur in the Middle Eastern Peninsula. Symptoms include fever, cough, and shortness of breath. Other symptoms may include nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.

YEAR	VIRUS
	Treatment includes rest, fluids, pain relievers, and oxygen therapy in severe cases. About 35% of those who are diagnosed with the disease die from it. Larger outbreaks have occurred in South Korea in 2015 and in Saudi Arabia in 2018
2020	TUBERCULOSIS VACCINE MAY HELP COVID-19 VICTIMS
March	In the Texas A&M University, A&M Health Science Center, Jeffrey Cirillo and his team are working on a critical bridge towards a full-blown preventive vaccine to help keep more infected people alive. They are testing health care workers to see if a decades-old tuberculosis vaccine might also help drive down the number of people being hospitalized and even dying from the new coronavirus. In the U.S., this vaccine is used to treat bladder cancer, effectively rekindling the immune system to fight off cancer cells. This boasting of the immune system is the effect researchers hope this vaccine will have on covid-19 patients, rekindling the immune system. PORTRAIT OF A CORONAVIRUS

According to Wikipedia, covid-19 is a member of a large family of viruses called coronavirus that were first identified in the 1960s. It causes a variety of respiratory-tract illnesses. The "family" takes its name from the distinctive "corona" or "crown" that projects from the surface of the virus. These projections are what enable the virus to bind to human cells, allowing entry and hijacking the host's (body's) cellular machinery in order to replicate itself.

Katy Steinmetz from her article "Coronavirus" (Steinmetz, April 2, 2020) says, "The word, 'virus,' comes from the Latin term meaning "venom" and describes a very tiny agent that causes infectious diseases. Coronavirus is a family of viruses that got its name from its appearance.

The word "corona" means "crown." Scientists in 1968 came up with the term. Under a microscope, the virus they looked at resembled a solar corona: the bright crown-like ring of gases surrounding the sun that is visible during a solar eclipse.

Covid-19 or coronavirus is a disease caused by one type of coronavirus: SARS or Cov-2.

"Pan" is the Latin and Greek word meaning "demon." It is related to the Greek word "poneros," which means hurtful or evil effect or influence" or "evil spirit." "Pan" is the origin of the word "pandemonium" and has the same meaning in the word "Pandemic." "Pandemonium" is defined as an uproar, an abode where all demons dwell, and a place of

wild and noisy confusion. Words related to "pandemonium" include "hell, hades, netherworld, etc." "Pandemonium" originally referred to a place called "Pangea (or Pangaea),"which was what earth was called when it was one land mass. "Pangea" was the vast, single super continent, comprising all the land on earth that existed. The Bible references a time when earth (or "Pangea") was split up or divided after Shem's great-great-grandson, Peleg (meaning "earthquake"), was born (Genesis 10:25 and 1 Chronicles 1:19).

"Pandemus" (pan + demos) is the origin of the word "Pandemic." We can think of a pandemic as widespread pandemonium, both having as a root the word "pan."

<u>Snake Venom</u> (Price, 2002, pg. 517) is symbolic of sorcery, its magic potions, and libations. These are all thought to give entrance into the deep mysteries of the world, in particular the world of satan. Venom is frequently imbibed as the elixir of mysticism to defy death and to court the higher powers of demonism,. Its intoxication permits, for the sorcerer, the seductions of the occult, such as, powers over death and ingestion of spiritual life and immediate capacity for spiritual revelation. Snake venom is also figurative of bitterness, envy, malice, and doom.
